presents that I Robert Peden of the State and district for and in consideration of sum of Eight hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John S Peden of the same place have given to me bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargained sell and release unto the said John S Peden all that

Plantation or tract of land containing Three Hundred & Thirty two and a half acres (more or less) situated and lying in the state and district aforesaid Beginning on a Hickory Stump 3X and running Thence S 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 76.00 to a White Oak sapling 3X bounded by Martin W Peden land thence N 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 42.75 to a Stake 3X bounded by Robert Peden & John Mapsey's land thence S 65 W 19.25 to a Stake 3X bounded by Bramblett's land, thence S 17 W 53.00 to a Stake 3X thence N 87 $\frac{1}{2}$ W 53.00 to a Red Oak 3X thence S 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 27.50 to the beginning corner bounded by John Thomas Peden's land. Together with all and singular the rights, menses, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the said John S Peden his heirs, and assigns, forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John S Peden, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my Heirs and against every other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming a to claim the same or any part thereof.
