Barrett of the County of Sumpter and State of Georgia for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Parker Cannon of Greenville District and State of South Carolina, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released unto the said Parker Cannon all that tract or parcel of land, situated in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on the waters of South River in Part Woodstock, it being a tract of land originally granted to John Barrett, Beginning on a ash joining Pines land thence S. 64 W. to a conditional corner, thence to a stake on H. B. Pines line thence S. 31 E. to a stake on Pines line, thence along Cannon line to a red oak on Parker Cannon old line thence N 70 W to a red oak thence N 35 W to a red oak, thence N 69 E to a stake, thence to a stake, thence N 61 E to a Chestnut, thence to the beginning corner, containing One hundred and Sixty five acres, more or less, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging in any wise incident or appur-
