 Beginning at a large Post Oak on the Duncombe road (now H. C. Synch's  
 corner), running thence N. E. with the Synch's line Two hundred feet to a stake, thence  
 N. W. One hundred and one feet to a stake - thence S. W. Two hundred to the  
 Duncombe Road, thence with the said road, one hundred and one feet to  
 the beginning corner being the Lot lying between H. C. Synch's and myself.
