



 me humbly moving do hereby constitute and appoint Thornton P Poole of Greenville  
 District South Carolina my true and lawful attorney for me and in my stead to  
 bargain sell and convey all and singular my right title and estate, legal  
 and equitable, of in altho all and singular the real estate in Greenville District  
 South Carolina of which the said John P Poole deceased died seized and possessed  
 consisting of the three following tracts Viz First The Home tract wherein the said  
 John P Poole deceased resided and died supposed to contain One Hundred and  
 Twenty four acres lying on the waters of Brush Creek and Cane River, and adjoining  
 lands of Reuben Daily Alfred P Poole and Thornton P Poole Second The Fox Branch  
 Tract containing Three Hundred and thirty five acres more or less lying on the waters of  
 Cane River, and adjoining lands of Wm. T. Justin Joseph Green Thornton P Poole and  
 William P Poole and Philip Daily and others Third The Packette Tract containing  
 Three Hundred and Sixty acres more or less, lying on the waters of Packette river  
 and adjoining lands of Elias R Whitten, Nancy Bandt and others And I do further  
 authorize and impower my said Attorney to execute and deliver the necessary deeds and  
 papers for the sale and conveyance of the Lands aforesaid to the purchasers thereof and to receive  
 and accept for the purchase money therefor and to take all notes bonds and mortgages  
 necessary for securing the payment of the same and generally to do and perform all such acts  
 matters and things in the premises as may be necessary or expedient for the complete and  
 effectual execution of the authority herein before granted as fully as I might or could
