W Powers shall at any time desire to give up and surrender the trust reposed in him by this deed it is understood and agreed that he may surrender the same by an endorsement on this deed to any person who may consent to receive the same, and to whom the said Isaac S Henning and Mary Henning shall consent in writing that the same may be surrendered.

And the same right shall inure to the Executor or Administrator of the said P. W Powers should he after his death desire to surrender the said Trust And the said Isaac S Henning doth covenant and bind himself to abide by and respect the provisions of this deed
