Bee my negro girl Lucinda In Trust for the sole and separate use of the said Harriet F. M. Bee during her natural life and at her death the said negro girl to be held by the said W. P. M. Bee trustee as a fund for his son Frank Butler M. Bee until he shall attain the age of Twenty one years of age and then the said negro girl with all her furniture increased to be delivered to him Provided his mother be then dead But if the said Harriet F. M. Bee shall still be living when her son shall have attained the age of twenty one years she is to retain the said
