Thompson and the said Tract No. 2 that purchased of Vardry McBee and containing Eighty acres more or less Beginning on a Spanish Oak corner running Thence N 23 W 90 to a Red oak corner Thence N 70 E 130 to a Stake and point Thence S 26 E 92 to a Stake Thence S 34 W 70 to Wm. Jacobs line Thence with said Jacobs line N 35 W 8 to Judge Thompson corner Thence N 32 W 48 to an old maple stump a rock on Brushy creek Thence along Judge Thompson line 66 poles to the beginning The tract No. 3 that purchased of W.
