To Have and to Hold the said price parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said W M Goodlett his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as the Massena Taylor Sheriff might could aught to grant, bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Fieri Facias a otherwise
