granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said John McKittrick all that tract of Land containing thirty nine acres more or less situated in Granville District and bounded of these four corners of Sides even to parts of Anne Rivers beginning at a black Sacke bush 3432 Thence on Charles Plague line S 87 E 1500 to lightwood stake 3432 Thence on John Higgins line S 86 E 1650 to stake by Georgia road Thence on William Martin line S 82 E 1100 to pine 34 Thence along the Georgia road to lightwood stake 34 near a large steeping Siding on the south side of the road Thence to a white oak corner on north of Spring 34 Thence on north side of branch crossing the branch to same side both on south side of branch 34 Thence S 18 E to beginning corner

Do give with all and singular the rights members incidents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appurtenant To have and to hold all and singular the above described premises to the said John McKittrick his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John McKittrick his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
