The above One hundred and Thirty Seven Acres of Land, being and bounded as follows Viz - Beginning on a Post oak 37 Thence S 55 W 40 to a red oak 37 Thence N 40 W 20 cks to a Chestnut 37 Thence N 12 E 27 cks to a Dogwood 37 near the head of a small branch Thence down the branch with the waters 9.50 cks to a Dogwood 37 Thence S 75 E 16 cks to a Post oak 37 Thence S 11 E 12.50 to a red oak 37 to the Stage road Thence S 58 E 14 cks to a stone with 57 rods Thence S 88 E 9.50 to a Post oak 37 with Walter Austin fence Thence S 3 E 2. cks 33 links to the Post oak to the Beginning to include One Hundred and Thirty Seven Acres by the same</p>
