Trust of John Moon deceased and an Executor of his will and also as agent
and representative for John Moon Robert Moon Sarah Conter and David Con-
ter her husband, Elizabeth Fair and her husband, Caroline Conter and the
children of Mary C Kilgaw deceased in consideration of the sum of Five
hundred & ten pounds paid by Cabin Bonar the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged
have bargained sold released and conveyed and by these presents do bargain sell
and convey to the said Cabin Bonar all the right interest and estate of the parties
aforesaid in certain negroes by a woman Hammill and two children Henry
John and Hannah which of the will of John Moon died now left to Nancy
P Moon during her life and after her death to his heirs at law who are the
persons above named and Blackmon P Sizor and Nancy Sizor his wife
and I do truly warrant this sale and release of me made in behalf of the parties
aforesaid good and effectual to convey their interest in said negroes except as to the
said Blackmon P Sizor and wife for whom no contract is undertaken
