Whence John Young deceased late
of the State and District aforesaid die
in and by his last Will and Testament, begueth and devise to his wife
Nancy Young for and during her natural life a widowhood, the Plantation
and tract of Land on which she then lived and of which he died seized and
possessed and directed by his said last will that at the death or marriage
of his said wife, the said land, reserving his graveyard, should be sold
by his executors and the net proceeds equally divided between his children
and grand children as therein named and directed And whereas in the
Legatees under the said Will by our Deed of Agreement and covenant dated
3rd of October 1848 did covenant and agree that the said Land except the
reservation aforesaid should be sold at Public Auction by Jesse Dean and
Robert P Goodlett two of the executors of the said last will on certain conditions
and terms in the said Deed set forth And whereas the said Land has been
sold by the said Executors at Public Auction in Compliance with the terms of
of said Deed And whereas upon the said sale Perry E Duncan did become the purchaser
thereof at and for the sum of Three Thousand Six Hundred and twenty four
Dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor. And whereas the said Perry
E Duncan has complied with the terms of the said sale. And therefore,
I now attest by these my true presents that we Mrs Nancy Young widow of the

by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Perry E Duncan
