 Thomas Stepp Deed Presents that S. William P. Peal of the  
 District of Greenville and State aforesaid  
 for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred ~~and~~<sup>even</sup> dollars paid by Harry  
 Stepp of the District and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold,  
 and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the  
 said Thomas Stepp, all that tract or parcel of Land containing One  
 Hundred and twenty two acres and a half acres more or less, situated  
 in the District and State aforesaid on the waters of Marsh Creek a branch  
 of South Tyger River. Beginning on a post oak thence N 44 E 15 to  
 a Stake. Thence N 30 W 28.50 to a stake. Thence N 70 E 15 to a stake thence  
 S 62 W 30 to a chestnut thence S 15 W 27.50 to a post oak thence S 40 W 16 to  
 a red oak thence a straight line to the beginning corner  
 Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments  
 and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
 To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
