Massena Taylor Sheriff aforesaid by virtue of said Writ of Fieri Facias aforesaid to me directed and delivered as aforesaid and by virtue of the Statute in such cases made and provided and for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars to me in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said W. H. Watson the receipt and payment whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargain and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said W. H. Watson his heirs and assigns forever, the said tract piece and parcel of land with its appurtenances and all the estate right title and interest which the said Sabiel Bradley of right had of, in and to the same

To have and to hold the said piece, parcel and tract of land with its appurtenances unto the said W. H. Watson his heirs and assigns forever as fully and absolutely as I the said Massena Taylor might and ought to grant bargain and sell the same by virtue of the statute aforesaid and the said Writ of Fieri Facias or otherwise
