 five years old To Have and to hold the said Negroes slaves and their future
 increase unto the said Joseph W Whitman his Executors, administrators and
 assigns forever Provided Always Nevertheless that if the said
 James A Harrison his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns shall
 and do will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Joseph W
 Whitman his certain attorney executor administrators or assigns the full
 and just sum of Sixteen hundred and twenty nine Dollars eight pence according to
 the true intent and meaning of the note under seal aforesaid and of these presents
 together with lawful interest thereon then this deed of bargain and sale and all
 and every clause, article therein contained shall cease determine and be utterly
