aforesaid the receipt whereof is fully acknowledged have bargained sold and released  
and by these presents do grant sell release confirm and convey unto the said  
Dennis Batson all that tract a parcel of land containing Eighty acres more  
or less Situated lying and being in the District and State of aforesaid on the  
back waters of Gap Creek a branch of Saluda river Beginning on a Stake  
near the rip rock running N 30 E to a chestnut Stake N 48 W 26.50 to a chestnut  
Stake S 76 W 27 to a post or Stake S 66 40 until it strikes the widow Callahans  
land Stake with his land until it strikes Robert Pitmans land and thence  
with said Pitmans land to the beginning of the tract of land  
granted to the said Joseph Barton. Together with all and singular the rights  
members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises and do  
hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators to quit claim to the
