Hendrick Chapman Lucinda Leonard Carter Chapman John Steady and Emily Steady for and in consideration of Three Hundred and Twenty Dollars to me in hand paid by Stacy Chapman of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Stacy Chapman a certain tract or piece of land containing Sixty seven Acres more or less lying on Datus creek branch of Ready Fork of Ready River Originally granted to Robert Gillow on the seventh of August 1788 then conveyed by him to W. Prasher then to Joseph Stegall then to Nathaniel Perry then to Hendrick Chapman then to Thomas Chapman by the power of Attorney and then to Stacy Chapman Beginning on a P.O. Stone N 28 E 19 chs to a Pine Stump N 28 W 15 1/2 chs to a dogwood N 45 W 20 1/2 chs to a P.O. Stone S 4 W 25 chs to a stump Stump S 50 E 8 chs to a P.O.
