to me in Land paid by William Stewart of the same District do hereby grant bargain sell
and convey and release unto the said William Stewart his Heirs and Assigns a certain
Tract or parcel of Land situated in the District aforesaid on Seven Mile Creek waters
of Middle River Beginning at a Red Oak on Joseph Smith's line there
with said line N 71° E 1490 to rock 3x Thence A 24° W 20.81 to maple 3x on said Good-
lett's and Stewart line Thence with said line S 60° W 17 ch to R C 3x down Thence S 15°
E 17 ch to Beginning containing Thirty Four Acres and other Woods to the same more
or less To have and to hold all and singular the said premises above described
and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns To
Warrant and defend forever the above described land unto the said William Stewart
his Heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns or any other person
lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof
