 Wesley Whitely and Jesse Cannon containing Four hundred and sixty two
 acres more or less and having such bounds, buttings lines and marks as
 are set forth in the two plat's One of 359 1/4 acres the other of 103 1/4 acres made by
 James W. Wickson W. S. 10th & 11th September 1847 being the Tract of Land known
 and called as the Brocke Tyger Place and which was sold and conveyed
 to Lawrence Brocke by Jno P Butler Commissaire in Equity for Greenville
 District for partition of the Real Estate of Henry Brocke died by deed
 bearing date the 20th February 1848 and by the said Lawrence Brocke
