 Greenville District presents That I George Washington Green of Greenville District
 John Belton O'Neal Land in the State aforesaid for and in consideration
 of the sum of Twenty eight hundred Dollars to me paid by John Belton
 O'Neal of Newberry District in the State aforesaid have granted bargained
 sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release
 unto the said John Belton O'Neal All that tract of Land situated lying
 and being in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on the Southc. Fork of Tyger
 River; adjoining lands of Spartan Goodlett Mathias Rush Jefferson Butler
 Wesley Givens and Jesse Cannon Containing Four hundred and sixty two
 acres more or less and having such houses, buildings trees and marks as
 are set forth in the two plats one of 35 1/4 acres the other of 10 3/4 acre made by
 James Hickson N. S. 10^o 8^m 21^s September 1847 being the tract of Land known
 and called as the Brock's Tyger Place and which was sold and conveyed
 to Lawrence Brock by the P. Butler Commissioner in Equity for Greenville
 District for partition of the Real Estate of Henry Brock who died by his
 decease date the 26th February 1848 land by the said Lawrence Brock
 conveyed to me by his decease date 25th June A.D. 1849

Together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments
 and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or app-
 pertaining To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned
 unto the said John Belton O'Neal his Heirs and Assigns forever And
 I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
 and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said John
 Belton O'Neal his Heirs and Assigns and against me and my Heirs and against
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
