

 eleven acres more or less, Situated in Greenville District on Sink Hole fork of Tyger
 River Beginning on a maple on the North side of the river James Henson cor-
 -ner Thence N 82 E 5 ch 75 S to a Spanish oak Thence N 25 E 17 ch 75 Sinks to a
 white oak Thence S 34 E 25 ch 50 S to a stake James Henson corner on the old
 Miller line Thence S 33 W 24 ch 30 S to Black oak Thence N 80 W 31 ch 50 S
 to a chestnut Thence N 12 E 30 ch to a small Hickory on the banks of the River Thence
 down the River with its several meanders to the beginning Being a part of a tract
 of Land granted to Allen Cowan Together with all and singular the rights mem-
 -bers hereditaments and appurtenances belonging to the same or in anywise incident
 or appertaining to it To have and to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said John Henson for his heirs and assigns forever and I
 do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant
