said Court having ordered a sale of the said Estate according to the Report of the Commissioner
In pursuance of the Decretal order of the Court of T P Butler Commissioner of the said Court
after legally advertising the same did on the first Monday of October in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty seven at Greenville Court House
expose to public sale the Tract of Land hereinafter described wheras John H. Joyce
became the purchaser of said Land for the sum of Five Hundred and Thirty Dollars being
at that price the last and highest bidde Now Therefore know all men by these
presente that I T P Butler Commissioner of aforesaid by virtue of the Decretal
order aforesaid and for and in consideration of the said sum of Five Hundred and
Thirty Dollars to me secured to be paid by the said John H. Joyce according to the
aforesaid order of the said Court have granted bargained sold and released and by
these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John H. Joyce his
heirs and assigns forever all that parcel or tract of Land situated in the
District aforesaid on Stony Creek said to contain One hundred and ninety four
acres marked and bounded as follows Beginning at a Stake 3x formerly a
Black Oak 3x W 58 E 5.70 Thence N 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ E 18.30 N 27 E 16.50 to Spanish
Oak by T Heyds Pipe fence Thence N 65 W 21.50 to a stake 3x Thence
S 25 E 25 to a stake 3x Thence N 78 W 25.50 to a maple 3x on branch line to
