of South Tyger river containing Two hundred and Sixty eight acres it being a tract  
of Land of which Samuel Boswell deceased died seized and possessed And we do hereby  
full intent in the said Benjamin Boswell his heirs and assigns forever our aforesaid claim  
in the said Tract of Land and do hereby forswear relinquish the same for the consideration  
of aforesaid in Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and seals This the  
8<sup>th</sup> September in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine
