 One hundred and twenty dollar to me in hand paid by Josiah Bramlett of the District
 and State aforesaid I have granted bargain sold and released and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Josiah Bramlett a plantation or
 tract of Land lying and being situated in the District and State aforesaid on north
 side of Bridge Fork of Cinders Creek wester of Counce River it being a part of
 a Tract Originally granted to William Gamble by his Excellency William Moultrie
 the first day of December 1794 The Lands to be conveyed lying on a rock 37
 S 15 E 14 N Stump and bush 34 in Peter Poullet. Jul 0 then with the various meadow
 of said Creek to my spring branch on a Stake 37 S 70 W 30 N beginning including forty
 Acres being the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights member
 here ditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident
 or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned unto the said Josiah Bramlett and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Exe-
 cutors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises
 before mentioned unto the said Josiah Bramlett his heirs and against every other per-
 son whomsoever claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
