Gum 3x3x on the bank of the creek Thence S 46 E 10.10 to Rock 3x in old field Thence on Bank of Yeargins Creek N 70 E 33.30 to a white oak 3x3x Thence N 45.46 degs to White oak on the bank of the creek Thence up the Meanders of said Creek to the beginning corner
