Johnson of the State and District aforesaid have bargained sold granted and released and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and release unto the said J. B. Johnson a certain Tract a parcel of Land situated in the State and District aforesaid on the waters of Ennore River containing Three Hundred and Fifty one acres more or less bounded by James belonging to J. M. A. Insipin Wm Pool Philip Daily Samuel Wentchins formerly John P. Pool and Joseph Green beginning at a Spanish Oak 34 north to John Pool's thence S 55 W 23 to a black gum on the creek 34 thence S 25 W 27, 50 thence with the meanders of the creek to the mouth of a branch thence up the branch to a stake 34 thence S to a white oak 34 on thence E 48 to a stake 34 on thence N 33.50 to a stake 34 on thence N 45 W to Jane Grayham, line with said line to where it intersects the old line of this Tract so as to cut off for her twenty acres more or less Jane Grayham said shall be in any other part of this Tract on purpose papers hereinafter it shall be located for her," thence to a Post Oak corner thence N 89 W 15 to a Spanish oak 34 the beginning corner containing Three hundred and fifty one acres more or less together with all and singular the premises hereditaments &c heretofore in any way appertaining thence to the said James B. Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described premises unto the said J. B. Johnson his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against every other person or persons who shall lawfully claim the same or any part thereof
