out any compulsion waive a fear of any person or persons whomsoever to release  
and give up relinquish unto Vincent Jenkins his heirs and assigns all her interest and  
estate and also all her rights and claims of master of in & to all and singular the  
premises mentioned and conveyed by the said husband Elijah McMillen unto the said  
Vincent Jenkins by deed for Two hundred acres of land lying in Greenville District  
where the said Elijah McMillen formerly lived.
