One Tract formerly belong to W. C. Evans. containing One hundred and ninety seven acres  
 more or less, being part of a Tract originally granted to Francis Cotton in  
 the year of Our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty four on the sixteenth day  
 of July witness his Excellency Benj: Gen:rd. Situated lying in the Dist-  
 rict and State aforesaid on the Golden Grove Creek waters of Saluda beginning  
 on an aspy corner on W. C. Evans line running thence N 58 E 145° to a Post Oak  
 corner thence N 6 W 28.50 to a Mulberry corner on the Little Grove Creek, then
