Sixteen Acres more or less bounded as follows, Beginning at Middle Thompsons
corner on the Lawrence road and running thence N. 35° E. to a wooden fence, runned
by Edward Craft between this Land and Mr. Scotts land thence S. 45°
E. along said line to Edward Crafts line thence S. 25° E. with Edward Crafts line
to the Lawrence road thence with the Lawrence road to the beginning, being the
Tract of Land wherein the said James H. Randolph now resides, and which he pur-
chased from Edward Craft.

borments and Appurtenancy to the said Premises belonging or in any wise in-
