 presents that I William Tucker of Greenville District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fifty Dollars to me paid by Solomon Jones of Henderson County North Carolina have granted bargain sold and released and to this purpose do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Solomon Jones all that tract of Land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville and State aforesaid on both sides of a branch of Still Camps Creek waters of the middle part of Saluda River containing One hundred and Sixty Acres and hath such Shop marks Cuttings Corn dices as the said Solomon Jones represents and to which reference might be had for a more particular description Said Land granted to William Tucker together with all and singular the Rights Members Hereditaments and Appurtenances belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Solomon Jones his heirs and assigns forever against myself my heirs or assigns lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. And I bind myself to you ever to warrant and defend the Rights of part of the above Land beginning at the fence where said Tucker and H. B. Potts farms on the North side of the plantation running north west to the beginning corner

Witness my hand and seal this Twenty fourth day of December Eighteen Hundred and forty seven and in the Seventh year of the Independence of the United States of America
