State and District aforesaid you and in consideration of the sum  
of Fifty Dollars fifty four and one quarter cents to me in hand  
paid by Estley W. Hudson of the State and District aforesaid the receipt whereof I do have  
acknowledged Meau Grant his Bargain sold and released and by these presents do Grant pay  
Selle and release unto the said Estley Hudson a certain Tract of Land containing  
Seven Acres and thirty three poles Situated in the State and District aforesaid on both the sides  
of Moores Mill Branch of Brush Creek Branch waters of White River to the  
same more or less, Beginning on Poplar tree on a small branch Thence W 27° E 90m  
Chains to a white oak tree Thence N 37° W 738 chains to Stake No. Thence S 54° W 775 chains  
to Stake 6 am 3x88 m. Thence S 55° E 44.40 chains to the Beginning Poplar

Together with all and singular the Rights members Boundaries and  
Appurtenances to the said property belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to the same.

I do have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned in the same  
the said Estley W. Hudson it is my and assigns from and I do hereby bind myself to  
my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and defend the above mentioned  
Premises unto the said Estley W. Hudson his heirs and assigns. Against myself and  
my heirs and against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof.
