and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by P.C.  
Duncan also of the District and State aforesaid the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge and  
know. Granted. Searched for and released and by these presents do grant bargains  
sell and release unto the said P.C. Duncan all that Tract of Land situated in  
lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on to the side of Sunday a Branch of  
the Little river of Horry River and known as the Clayton place being the same tract  
conveyed by Thomas G. Walker to County Clayton by Deed bearing date the twenty fourth  
day of October 1831 which will now fully appear by reference to said deed containing  
One hundred and One acres more or less and bounded on all sides by lands now owned  
by the said P.C. Duncan.

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned to  
the said P.C. Duncan his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my  
heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and  
singular premises before mentioned unto the said P.C. Duncan his heirs and assigns  
against myself my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns and against every other  
person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming as to claim the same or any part thereof.
