the said sealed note and also in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars by the said
to the said Samuel Maundin and Co Elford Executors as aforesaid to me the said E. S. Birne
my hand paid up and before the sealing and delivery of these presents do grant, bargain
and sell, all and singular convey and confirm unto the said Samuel Maundin and Co El-
ford Executors as aforesaid and to their heirs and assigns forever all that piece of land
and tract of Land this day sold and conveyed by the said Samuel Maundin and
Co Elford Executors as aforesaid to the said E. S. Birne in pursuance of the last will and
Testament of the said Edmund Waddill deceased lying and being on Long Branch
and Reedy Rivers in the District and State aforesaid and containing Thirteen hundred
and three acres more or less according to a survey and estimation made by John C.
Heath Esq. adjoining of Carlo Foster, McChamahaw, Elwood, Cleveland and McBee
and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a stake of iron a mark distance along
the said rd and going across Reedy River and running thence N 59° W 2.5 to a stake 400
ft from thence W 10° N 10° to another stake back 37 m from thence N 36° W 2.70 to a stake
3x East and 37 m from thence up the meander of Reedy River to an acre 3x
