in a Post of Thomas running along South 74 N 36 to a post on the 32 boundaries of
Henry Stokes Land Thence South 16 E 57 to a stake 32 bounded by the said Cooley's
Thence N 16 W 22 to a Post on the 32 (end down) bounded by the said Cooley's Thence
with said Cooley's line till it intersects with the above stone line to a bearing station
N 16 E to a Post on the Spring branch Thence down the same branch to a near
the branch to Mountain Creek Thence up said creek all lands from the bank
to the old original line Thence with the original line to the beginning containing
Two Hundred and Thirty Three Acres more or less
