 Coor of the same place. He has granted, bargained and sold the present land set out
 above unto the said William Coor all that Tract or parcel of Land containing one
 hundred and fifty Acres more or less lying in Greenville District of the State of South
 Carolina of which the said Coor claims a part of a Tract of Land which he sold to the
 said Coor now lying and being situated as follows Beginning on a Stake on
 the one side John Coors line Thence E or S E line to Thomas Austins line Thence
 S E to a 40th East corner on James M Austins line Thence S E a distance
 of a Hickory corner on S. W. Stens line Thence West to a Stone corner on S. W. Stens
 line Thence North to the beginning corner including One hundred and fifty
 acres more or less Together with all and singular the Rights, tenures and appur-
 tenances to the said William Coor his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind
 myself my Heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns To warrant and save the said
 the above described Land unto the said William Coor his heirs and assigns forever
 all persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or hereafter to claim the same or any part
 thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal
 the 29th day of April In the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and
 forty eight
