give sell and release unto the said James A. Moore all that piece or parcel of Land
containing Two Hundred and fifty eight acres more or less being a part of the tract
originally owned and possessed by George Craft deceased and lying in the State and Dist
such as is set out on Reedy Fork waters of Reedy River and known James A. Moore
now lives and according to a late survey hath such corners and marks cuttings
and bounding as a public Accountant would plainly show

Do give with all and singular the rights members hereditaries
and appurtenances belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining

To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto
the said James A. Moore except a narrow road twelve feet wide and thirty feet long
to his heirs and assigns forever unto I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and
Administrators it warrant and force defende all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said James A. Moore his heirs Executors and Administrators
against myself and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
same or any part thereof
