Summerville and State aforesaid bounded by James, Uttinger Wesley Phillips Washington  
Towall Grande and Dandland and others Together with all and singular the rights  
privileges immunitments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise  
incident or appertaining to same and to hold all and singular the premises above  
mentioned unto the said Mr. Watson his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby  
bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all  
and singular the said premises unto the said Mr. Watson his heirs and assigns against  
ourselves our heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim  
the same or any part thereof.
