side of Saluda River Beginning on a Oak Apple Tree on the bank of the River
running Thence N 41° E 18 chains to a red oak tree Thence N 19 W 52 chains to a Stake
37 Thence W 88 chains to the River and thence down the meander of the River to the
beginning containing One Hundred Acres more or less being the same Tract con-
veyed to the said John Cleveland by William Blaxingame Sheriff of Greenville Dist
which by Deed dated the 6th day of June 1832 as by reference shall well now fully appear

To witness with all and singular the Right, Member, & constituents
and affinitaries to the above mentioned premises belonging or any in anywise
incident or appertaining to them and to hold all and singular the premises above
mentioned unto the said Joseph W. Harrison his heirs and assigns forever And
I do hereby bind the Heirs of the said John Cleveland to warrant and forever
defend all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said Joseph W.
Harrison his heirs and assigns against themselves and their heirs only from claiming
the said Tract of Land or any part thereof.
