 bargain sold and release and conveyed and by these presents, do grant bargain sell  
 release and convey unto the said Samuel J. Waddell his heirs and assigns forever all  
 that plantation or tract or land situated lying and being in the District of Greenville  
 of said Ga in the Golden Grove Creek branch waters of Saluda River containing Two Hundred  
 and thirty eight acres, more or less adjoining lands belonging to William Green, Et al  
 Farmers, Adam Jones Samuel Williams, William Means, William G. Garrison and Mrs  
 Ann Pace and that such same are marked as follows: Beginning at a Stake  
 37 on the banks of the Golden Grove Creek being the corner with Samuel Williams, and run-  
 -ing thence S 42° W 34.57 to a Pine Oak 37 thence N 57° W 27.75 to a Spruce Oak 37 thence  
 N 13° W 11.00 to a Stake 37 thence S 74° W 25.00 to a Post Oak 37 thence S 14° E 11.00 to a  
 Stake 37 thence N 74° E 2.90 to a Post Oak 37 thence S 30° E 19.80 to Stake 37 thence  
 140° E 12.50 to a Stake 37 thence S 45° E 24.00 to a small Hickory 37 thence S 80° E 11.00 to a  
 Stake 37 thence S 13° W 4.33 to a small Post Oak 37 thence S 45° E 22.00 to a Hickory  
 37 on the Green road. Thence across said road N 75° E 1.00 to a Hickory 37 thence  
 Road S 57° E 10.17 to a white oak 37 thence on said road S 36° E 11.10 to Sweet Gum 37  
 N 2° E 27.27 to a white oak 37 thence N 13° E 10.75 to a Stake 37 thence N 11° E 1.00 to a  
 Stake 37 on the bank of the Golden Grove Creek thence up the meanders of said Creek to
