Malone Two Hundred Acres of Land being the south east portion of that
land containing Four Hundred and Eighty acres convey to the School
House & Michael McPride lying and being in Greenville District on Ferry's
Branch creek a branch of the Watch Park & Saluda River and hath
put upon marks and counters as represented a Plat of John H. Story
which Survey was made the this day of August 1838 (Thirty seven and attack
years) to the Head made by John A. Sibley Superintendent of Public Works in John H.
and pair to has bounded towards the North by Lands now a State Game Improvement East of
the above water course called a creek

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, tenements
and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-
taining thereto.

To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned
unto the said Thomas Allison before mentioned unto the said Thomas W Malone
during his life & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executrix,
Administrators to warrant and from defend all and singular the said premises
with the said Thomas W Malone his Heirs and assigns against me and mine
and all persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty two in the
independence of the United States of America
