and demands to which I am or may become entitled against him as the Administrator
of the said W. McGoodlett deceased. And I do hereby warrant and defend the title
to his said estate herein before recited together with all and singular the rights
and determinants and Affinities to the same belonging or in anywise in-
appertaining to the said William McGoodlett his heirs and assigns against
myself and my heirs back against no other person or persons whomsoever lawfully
claiming the same or any part thereof.
