and administrators to warrant and defend all and singular law
that shall at any time hereafter be made or passed by the Legislature of the State of New
York or of the United States of America or of either of them or of any other place or places
where the same may be enacted or made or of any person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
or otherwise. And I do hereby give and grant to the said H. C. Montgomery William West and G. W. McCandell
my aforesaid distributive share in consideration of the foregoing relinquishment by them
of all and every assignment of Mary McCandell to them by giving up and bargaining and
all assigning and setting over unto the aforesaid Mary McCandell the right and privilege
to remain on freely occupying and freely using the entire sum tract aforesaid
