Fifteen Thousand one hundred and fifty dollars to which I now add the following
negroes, Harry & Fannie his wife who now the give younger children amounting
in all to Eighteen Thousand one gift dollars I now give to my daughter Eliza
Jones in Trust as her after shall give the following property which I estimate
of equal value with that given to the brother The tract of land on Wickham's
for which I have given to her a Deed of Conveyance and now the following negroes whom
I formerly held at Elizabethtown, Weymouth, Monday & Miller and their dependents, Celler, Sam,
the three children, two boys child the above named negroes I give in Trust to Eliza
to John W Jones in the only proper use and benefit and receipt of my said daughter
the Celler W Jones such time as she may claim them at her death I wish
no wife to be subject to the sale or disposition of the said John W Jones and
subject to his contracts and engagements as I am now in debt but anticipate the
receipt of money enough to pay these debts yet as it is possible I may not receive the
amount as a consideration to the above gift to my children that it is agreed it my
daughter shall pay \$300. in the amount given her son the same amount on
his land the whole of the property to remain in my possession until the end of the next
year.
