beginning corner Chestnut tree thence . . . Park with thence to a Chestnut tree with
a fence a conditional thence to a pine on a ditch line thence to a rock corner thence
on the banks of the creek thence down the bank to Noah Ballou's tree thence up the
branch ditch to a persimmon tree thence to a Millbury or Noah Ballou's tree thence
to a chestnut near the head of a spring thence to the beginning corner for and more or less
a deduction of the dam the same is forty and fifty rods and Jacob Ballou do
do hereby warrant and give full power against myself my heirs and assigns
of executors administrators and any other person or persons claiming with me to claim the
same or any part thereof the 13th December 1851
