The State of South Carolina

To all to whom these presents shall come I Sandy Walker of Greenville District in the State aforesaid have Graffing Whereas I the said Sandy Walker am indebted to John H. Joyce by note under seal bearing date the twentieth in the just and full sum of Three Thousand dollars payable the day the State thereof as in and by the said note under seal William Wimbley my and now do fully and at large appear

That I know by the said Sandy Walker for his decease the payment of the said sum above mentioned unto the said John H. Joyce his Executor Administrators and Assigns together with lawful interest the same have bargained and sold unto the said persons the slaves aforesaid in plain and open market delivered unto the said John H. Joyce all right title and interest in and to the following named negroes slaves To Miss Mary a negroe woman of copper complexion aged about forty three years a female of dark complexion aged about eighteen years Maria of dark complexion aged about sixteen years Henry of dark complexion aged about fourteen years Warren of dark complexion aged about 12 years Paul of light complexion aged about 10 years Ann and her two children Tom and Sarah all three persons Jefferson Belcher a negroe of copper complexion aged about 35 years and Jordan of dark complexion male aged about 47 years

To have and to hold the said negroes slaves unto the said John H. Joyce his Executors Administrators and Assigns forever provided always nevertheless That if the said Sandy Walker his Executors Administrators shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said John H. Joyce or his certain attorney Executors Administrators and Assigns the full and just sum above mentioned according to the true intent and meaning of the sealed note aforesaid and of these presents then this slave of negroes slaves and all and every other article and thing therein contained in case determined and be utterly void and of none effect any thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding

And it is hereby declared by and between the parties unto the said Sandy Walker for himself his heirs Executors Administrators and Assigns doth witness further and agree to and with the said John H. Joyce his Executors Administrators and Assigns by these presents that if default shall happen to be made to or in payment of the said sum above mentioned according to the true intent and meaning of the said memorandum note and seal that then and in such case the said John H. Joyce may be lawfull to send to the said John H. Joyce his Executors Administrators and Assigns from time to time and at any time hereafter precisely in quality to enter into any or all the messengers slaves or instruments of the said Sandy Walker and to take the aforesaid negro slaves into his custody and possession and to have and to hold and detain the same for his own use and benefit as his own proper goods and chattels from thenceforth and forever or the same to sell and dispose of at his will and pleasure returning the sum total if any short & happen to be after paying the sum above mentioned unto the said John H. Joyce his Executors Administrators and Assigns.
