presents That I William S. Carlton of the said District in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum
and sum of \$1000.00 paid by William Dickson of Granville District in the State aforesaid to me and my wife
Anne granter bargains sale and release unto these presents do grant bargain and
release unto the said William Dickson all that Tract or parcel of Land lying along
situated in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of Elisha Thompson's Branch situated
near Middle Ferry River Beginning at a White Oak tree and runs N 39 W to a
Rock Oak & a Pine Tree & thence runs a chain back thence S 87 E 44 1/2 rods to
a Stake & thence A pole back to the beginning containing Fifty Four acre on the said
River being the same more or less described by Survey belonging to William S. Carlton
and others and with such marks and farn as a plat of the same made the 28th day of May 1831 will more fully represent.

Do give unto all and singular the Rights, Members, Heirlooms and other
Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining thereto

To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned
unto the said William Dickson his heirs and assigns forever And do hereby bind myself
self my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular
of the said premises unto the said William Dickson his heirs and assigns against me and sing
my heirs and against every other person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same
any part thereof.
