 situated in the Town of Greenville in the said State which I now use do being known
 and designated as Lot No Seven in the N.W. Square of said Town according to Bar-
 ners plan of the same being at the east corner of Avenue and Jackson Streets being
 one hundred and seventeen and a half feet upon Avenue Street and one hundred
 and fifty feet upon Jackson Street with the back lines running at right angles
 to the said Streets and corresponding in length with the front lines The said Lot having
 been conveyed in the year 1816 by Vardry McPherson to my late husband C. Washington
 Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments
 and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining
 To have and to hold all and singular the premises before men-
 tioned unto the said John Wesley Brooks his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby
 give myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and give defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said John Wesley Brooks his heirs and assigns
