of Beaufort District presents that we the aforesaid  
Singgs and Sarah Singg both of the said State do  
hereby and State aforesaid in consideration of the aforesaid

the sum of Six hundred dollars to us in hand paid by John C Garrison and  
William C of the same State and District have this day made Bargain and  
Sold and Released and do by these presents grant bargain sell and remise unto  
the said John C Garrison and William C of their heirs executors and  
successors all that certain tract or parcel of Land lying on the Reedy River in the  
District of Reedy River Beginning at a Post Oak and running thence N 45° W 100 feet  
W 100 chains 50 links E. Stake Thence S 49° E 28 chains to a Post Thence N  
N 45° E 25 chains to a Pinetree Thence N 36° W 17 chains 75 links to a Post  
Chestnut Oak Thence N 69° E 17.66 to a Black Oak Thence S 36° W 21 chains to the same  
Beginning Post Oak corner containing by estimation One Hecadre and one half  
acres to the same more or less.

Be it also witness with all land singular the rights, members, conditions  
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining  
to the same and to hold all and singular the said premises with all the  
appurtenances unto the said John C Garrison and William C of their heirs  
executors and administrators and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs and  
executors and administrators and successors to defend the said premises with the appurtenances  
unto the said John C Garrison and William C of their heirs executors and  
administrators from all and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming  
to claim the same or any part thereof.

same sworn to and subscribed before me this 27<sup>th</sup> day of Oct 1851
