John McCallough to certain Tract of Land lying and being on the waters of Branch
the State and District aforesaid and whereas the said Thomas Roe deceased did
bequeath himself his administration or assigns to make titles unto the said John McCallough
to the said Land whenever the same should be paid for Now know ye that we
undersigned heirs at law of Thomas Roe deceased being all of the State and district
aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Dollars to us paid by John
McCallough of the aforesaid State and District. Know ye that we and so do and retain
by these presents do grant Bargain sell and release unto the said John McCallough
certain Tract of land containing Twenty Acres the same more or less sit
and consist of in said District or as branch on the waters of Branch River and bounded as
follows Beginning on a pine near the aforesaid path thence along the old path
to the said pine thence along said line to a Stake corner where said pine crosses
the old path made by Miller Bates thence a straight line from said Stake
thence to a poplar corner over a small branch thence a straight line to the beginning
thence

To have and to hold all and singular the rights appurtenances
belonging to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenance
to the said premises and to have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid unto
the said John McCallough his heirs and assigns forever and we do bind ourselves
to the said John McCallough his heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular
the said premises unto the said John McCallough his heirs and assigns against
all and singular persons whomsoever claiming or to claim
aforesaid premises or any part thereof.
