I grant, bargain sell and unto the said French C. Carson and Martha A. his
wife all that Tract of Land situated lying and being in Spartanburg and Greenville
districts on both sides of Middle Ogee River beginning at a Stake 34 at the edge
of the bottom land on the west side of the said river and thence W 88 1/2 E along
the bottom land to a sloping oak at the eastern edge of the bottom land
thence the same course to the outside line of the McMakin Tract thence south
along the outside line of the McMakin Tract to the N.E. corner of the John Coffey Tract
thence S 11 E 24 1/2 W to a small ridge line thence S 78 1/2 W crossing the River and
other Stump thence south 12.00 to P. 034 on Middle Line thence W
45 to a Stake 34 on Thomas J. H. 100 ft. to a Stake 34 on Jordan Ridge thence with
the ridge to a line of a Tract of Land formerly owned by James McMakin
thence with said line W 84 1/2 E to a large oak 34 thence S 10 1/2 W to a Stake 34
thence W 15 1/2 E to a Stake 34 thence W 24 1/2 E to a Stake 34 thence S 84 1/2 W 15 1/2 E to
a large Stump S 40 W 93 1/2 E to a large Red Oak thence S 68 W 32 1/2 E to a Stake 34
thence W 46 1/2 E to a Stake 34 thence N 55 1/2 E a chain 34 on the Jordan road thence
with the outside line of a new entry of Party Line acres to the present line.
